Hi everyone!

Hope you're all having a wonderful summer! Most of you took part in the bipartisan meeting we held in Phoenix in early May, to discuss urgent needs facing the field of elections and democracy this year, in 2022. Out of that meeting came ideas on which we're currently taking action, like adding an option for communications assistance to the services being offered by EOLDN to election officials (look for that to be announced in September).

We're inviting this same group (plus a few new people who can add some further expertise) to another meeting of this group, this time in Detroit, Michigan on either August 31 or September 1, with Secretary Benson hosting us in her beautiful state. The meeting will take place most of the day at a venue TBD in the Detroit area. For those interested, we will also likely take in a Tigers game at beautiful Comerica Park the night of Aug. 31 (regardless of which day we hold the meeting). As with the last meeting, this meeting will be a structured but informal conversation, private and off the record, about the threats and challenges we all face heading into the midterms (and beyond), and identify strategies and gaps that need to be filled.

As soon as possible, please let me know if you can attend, and if so, whether Aug. 31 or Sept. 1 works better for you.

Hope to see you all in Detroit later this summer for another good conversation. Hotel and other information will follow. If you'll need assistance paying for travel, CEIR can assist if you can legally accept. And we will try to schedule the meeting so that individuals who want to fly in for the day can do so, without spending a night.
